In 1998 Dr. Andrew Wakefield and his team published an article in The Lancet medical journal. His scientific paper stated that he had found a link between the MMR vaccination and autism and bowel disease in children.

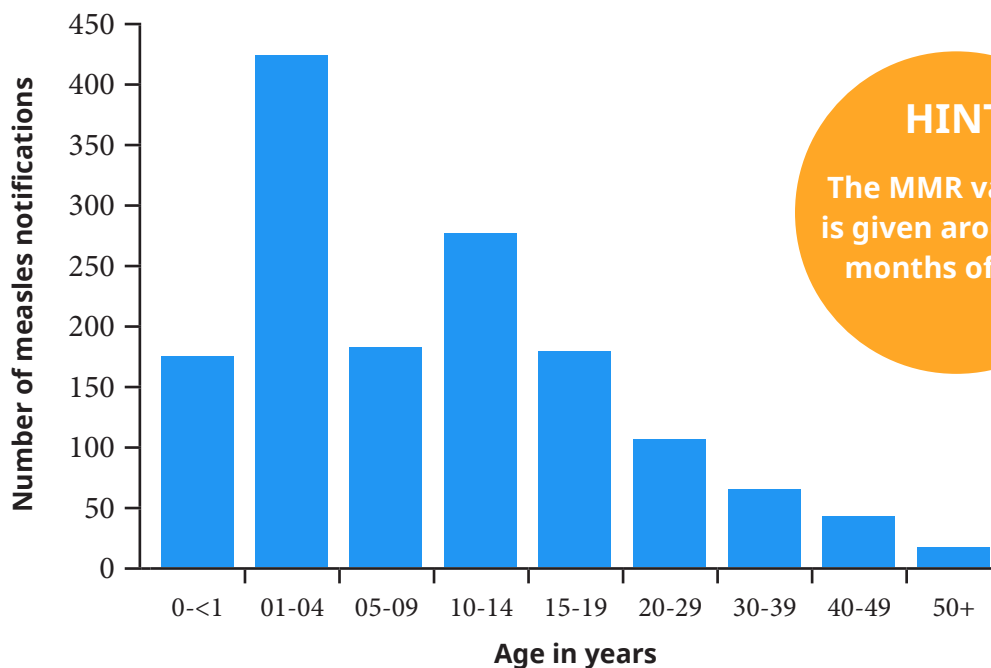
A media storm ensued.

Despite The Lancet paper being formally withdrawn and the thorough discrediting of the paper with an over-whelming amount of independent research supporting the safety of the vaccine; uptake of the vaccine dropped incredibly in that year and for many years after.

An outbreak of Measles occurred in England 2012/13.

Study the graph of the rate of measles for different age groups below and the timeline and consider the questions which follow.

5. Looking at the timeline can you suggest why this might be the case?
