Worksheet 6 – National Party Convention Statements Ranking

Consider how important are the national nominating conventions and rank the statements below in order of their importance on the diamond.

- 1. The convention ratifies the party's nominee and allows the party to unite around the chosen candidate.
- 2. The convention is the only time that the political parties meet nationally, otherwise they remain as 50 separate state parties.
- 3. The convention puts forward the party's official policy positions and adopts them. Although they have already been shaped and determined prior to the convention.
- 4. The presidential candidates hope to achieve an electoral bounce after the convention. In 2016 polls indicated that Trump received a post convention bounce of 2-3 per cent whilst Clinton's was 5-6 per cent.
- 5. It is used as an opportunity to announce the vice-presidential candidate, although this is almost always known beforehand.
- 6. It allows those opposed to the winning candidate to demonstrate their opposition in a democratic way. Although the party mainly seeks to ensure this is minimised.
- 7. It allows the parties to project their candidates in the media on a national platform.
- 8. The convention enables the party's supporters to meet and network in a way that they would not normally be able to do.
- 9. The party are able to publically demonstrate the diversity of their own support base to a wider nation.
