Fact sheet 1: Anti-corruption in Simonista

One approach to development is to look at how to improve governance.

Aim: Suggest possible solutions to the issues identified and then research what *did* happen in Georgia.

The important point is to look at how far they have come which can be illustrated with the Transparency International table, showing where Georgia lies in international rankings:
