

## **Developing AO2 essay skills in GCSE Geography Using a mnemonic**



Some teachers and schools encourage students to use a **mnemonic** when analysing a pattern or distribution; each letter of a word serves as a reminder of an analytical point that must be made.

One example is the CASE mnemonic.

Take every opportunity to practice writing evaluative essays during your course. You can use the CASE mnemonic to help create your essay plans.

С	Make Connections and links between different ideas or topics.
AS	Apply the Specialised concepts such as scale, feedback and threshold.
Е	<b>Evaluate</b> like a geographer. (Essay mark scheme may additionally require an evaluative conclusion.)
